From the Desk of Fr. Craig Cameron

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

For the longest time, I have been pondering the meaning of our Baptism: the mystery of it and the glory of it. Do we take time to appreciate that through Baptism, we become sharers in God's divine life? As stated in the Catechism, Baptism is the basis of our Christian life: "It is the gateway to life in the Spirit" and gives us access to the other Sacraments; once baptized, we are reborn anew in Christ, and we are "incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission." St. Augustine teaches that we need baptismal grace to live our faith, but we must also cooperate with grace to flourish fully. Baptism empowers us not only to live what we believe but to love each other as Jesus loves us. That is our most extraordinary mission. The Holy Season of Lent is a preparation for renewing our Baptism promises at Easter. Our penances and good works lay the groundwork for consciously renewing those promises and the choice to live them earnestly. As we continue our Lenten journey, I pray you get ready to renew those promises with your whole heart so that at Easter, when we celebrate the Lord risen in glory, we will together renounce our ancient enemy and his works and then confess our faith in the Holy Trinity, the Catholic Church, the Communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and eternal life. The time is at hand to embrace again the Divine Life of Jesus, the fruit of our Baptism and the fullness of life He came to bring.
